FIRED UP, READY TO GO!

Sunday, March 26 Pastor Ulysses Stephen King, Jr. preached a powerful sermon FIRED UP, READY TO GO!: PASSION, PARTNER, and POWER (Philippians 4:13). [Note: This sermon was inspired after listening to former President of the United States, Barack Obama's speech in New Hampshire, November, 2016.]

Christians have too many cans and not enough: change, commitment, consistency, and compassion. We often hold the church hostage by saying what we can do and not doing it.

Transform "I can" into "I will"!

- † You must have the **PASSION** for ministry!
- † We need help! The Holy Spirit didn't want Paul to do it alone, and we are **PARTNERS** with Jesus Christ!
- *† We need the power! If we have the <u>passion</u>, God will give us the <u>partner</u>, and then there is <u>power</u>! The Holy Spirit is our **POWER**!

THE RESURRECTION OF OUR LORD & SAVIOR, JESUS CHRIST

Season of Lent | March 1st - April 13th



Lent is a 40-day fast and will run up until the Saturday before Easter or Resurrection Sunday (not including Sundays within this period). The Lent period reflects when Jesus fasted and suffered in the desert for 40 days and 40 nights, before he started his ministry.

According to the Bible, he was tempted by

Satan during this time, but each time he managed to refuse his temptations. People follow Jesus' example and give up vices in a bid to grow closer to God as Easter or Resurrection Sunday approaches.
