According to the Bible, he was tempted by Satan during this time, but each time he managed to refuse his temptations. People follow Jesus' example and give up vices in a bid to grow closer to God as Easter or Resurrection Sunday approaches.

OUTCOMES OF THE FEBRUARY 19 ALL CHURCH PLANNING MEETING


Thank you to all who participated in the February 19th All Church Planning Meeting!

Let us not forget those members of our church unable to be with us due to illness and age. Call them, send them a card, but most importantly, say a prayer for them.


