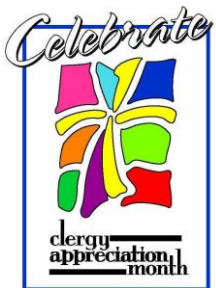
- in places lacking health & educational resources and/or where disaster has struck;
