Keynote Speaker **Fr. Paul Manning**

Ordained in 1985 for the Diocese of Paterson, Fr. Manning was appointed Vicar for Evangelization and Executive Director of St. Paul Inside the Walls by Bishop Emirates Serratelli in June of 2012. His vocation was nurtured, as the eighth of ten children, in the faithful home of his large family, and was discovered while studying wildlife management at Virginia Tech. After completing undergraduate studies in philosophy, he earned an S.T.B. and M. Div. at St. Mary's Seminary and University in Baltimore, MD. His assignments since then have included ministry as a parochial vicar and pastor. As diocesan vocation director for ten years, he worked with men and women in discernment and formation. He served in the field of education for nineteen years as chaplain, theology teacher, president of a Catholic high school, and Vicar for Education. Fr. Manning is excited to be engaged in the ministry of the New Evangelization. Convinced that God reveals himself in truth, goodness and beauty, and most especially in a relationship with Jesus, the Lord, he feels blessed to be living and working at St. Paul Inside the Walls, the Catholic Center for Evangelization of the Diocese of Paterson.

Workshop #1

Say the Word and My Soul Shall be healed

Facilitator: Matthew DeCaux

"Say the Word and My Soul Shall Be Healed." This presentation is geared towards discussing the importance of the Eucharist and coming out of the pandemic and the need to receive Holy Communion. This presentation will provide a great insight into the Eucharist for all those attending.

Matthew is the Regional Catechetical Consultant for Loyola Press. He has worked and volunteered in the catechetical field for many years. He has been a PCL and catechist in the Arch-Diocese of Newark. Matt has faithfully served our diocese well.

Workshop #2

FRONT AND CENTER: Connecting a generation that likes to serve with the Eucharist as Source and Summit

Facilitator: Kevin Dowd

Sponsored by PFLAUM Kevin will draw on his experiences working with youth and college students to suggest that evangelization works best when we pay attention to this generation's commitment to justice, service, equality, human rights and dignity. This is most fruitful, though, when we make explicit the link between our good works and our participation in the Eucharist. Without it, we have helped to form humanitarians, perhaps, but not Christians. A specific way of making this link will be presented.

Kevin Dowd, is a Doctor in theology and education at Boston College, worked under the advisement of Thomas H. Groome. He has taught in Catholic schools in both MA and NY. A graduate of Harvard University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in history, Kevin volunteered for two years with the Capuchin Youth and Family Ministries center in Garrison, New York. He earned his master's in education from the Institute of Religious Education and Pastoral Ministry at Boston College in 2008. His research interests include religion and public education, inter-religious dialogue, and bullying in the schools.

Workshop #3

A Call to Prophetic Discipleship... Evangelization and Catechesis in a COVID Ridden World

Facilitator: Fr. John Hurley

Secretariat for Evangelization, where he served for almost nine years, the National Pastoral Life Center in New York City and from 2010-2014, the newly established Department of Evangelization for the Archdiocese of Baltimore.

Workshop #4

Representó a la Universidad Franciscana con el proyecto Formando Líderes para la Iglesia, siendo seleccionado como la mejor práctica catequética para la formación de líderes, en el Congreso Internacional de Catequesis 2021 en Chile, coordinado por la Universidad Finis Terrae

Workshop #5

Rooted: Theology of the Body

This session will support, re-energize, and give hope for all of the goodness yet to come in ministry. . . and recognize all of the hard work they have done to keep the mission moving forward. But in

the end even more important than the songs and the movements and the activities experienced, this session will encourage attendees to rediscover what it feels like to come to Jesus as a child remembering that we are not only ministering to children, but that WE OURSELVES are children of God, too. *Sponsored by Our Sunday Visitor, Katie is the Director of Religious Education and Family Ministry at Saints Peter & Paul in Hoboken and a special projects consultant for Our Sunday Visitor. Her ministry brings the people of God back to basics-connecting with the Holy Spirit through breath, uncovering joy in the small things exploring creative expression, and experiencing God through the eyes of a child because that's who we are-children of God! Katie's ministry experience runs the gamut-but she is especially known for her gifts of music, communication, and storytelling. Workshop #7 A Promising Solution Facilitator: Deidre Nemeth

In response to the present-day challenge of a diminished faith among Catholics, there is a new Mass-centered Family Faith Formation program taking root in parishes, that presents a promising solution to renewing the Catholic faith life among families. This innovative approach to Religious Education moves beyond a sole reliance on the classroom model for children and teens and brings the entire family, parents, and their children, into both learning and sacramentally living the Catholic faith, inclusive of attending Mass. Participants will learn, how to incorporate the following three core components into the structure of Faith Formation that appeals to and engages the entire family. Deidre, will present the development, religious foundations, and practical applications of this Christ-centered program.

Deidre has been a Director of Faith Formation for over 12 years in the Diocese of Paterson. Deidre authored a book titled "I am the Way, the Truth and the Life: A Family Faith Formation Program for the New Evangelization." Bishop Emeritus Serratelli, of Patterson, wrote the forward for the book, describing it "as one of the most successful new approaches of our times." And, on August 19, 2022 Patterson Bishop Sweeney gave her book the Imprimatur.

Además, se ha desempeñado como Coordinador de Formación de Laicos Hispanos para la Diócesis de Metuchen. Padre Juan tiene un título universitario en Periodismo y Comunicaciones de la Universidad de Antioquia en Medellín, así como una Maestría en Divinidad de St Mary's Seminary and University en Baltimore, MD.

Looking for practical ways to bring the Eucharistic revival to the hearts of your students or your whole program? Join me for creative and tangible ways to do just that!

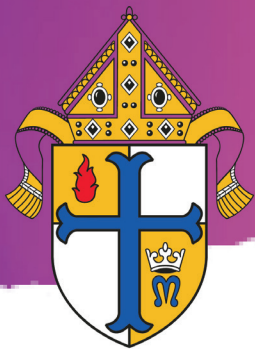

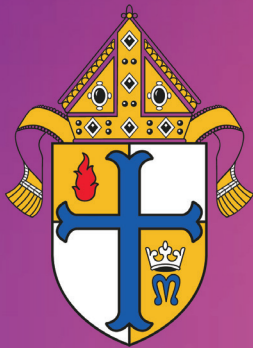
