Documents Necessary to Apply for Food Stamp:

- Identification (for everyone in the household)
- Social Security Cards (for everyone in the household)
- Utility Bills (gas, electric, oil, water, and telephone)
- Rent Receipt/Agreement or Mortgage Statements and/or Tax Bill.
- Proof of Income (for everyone on the household)
- Medical Expenses – Only if you are 60 and older and/or disabled
- Children's Day Care expenses

Attention: If you are a permanent resident, you must have at least 5 years of residency to qualify for food stamps. If you are non-documented, and have children that are American citizens, you can apply for food stamps on their behalf.

If you already receive Food Stamps, the Food Bank's staff cannot change the amount you already receive. If you are approved for food stamp benefits, food pantries and food distribution resources will continue to provide food for you.
