

## EIGHT AMENDMENTS TO US CONSTITUTION – VOTING RIGHTS

1. **12th Amendment:** Modifies and clarifies the procedure for electing vice-presidents and presidents.
2. **15th Amendment:** Reserves citizens the suffrage rights regardless of their race, color, or previous slave status.
3. **17th Amendment:** Establishes popular voting as the process under which senators are elected.
4. **19th Amendment:** Reserves women’s suffrage rights.
5. **23rd Amendment:** Reserves the right of citizens residing in the District of Columbia to vote for their own Electors for presidential elections.
6. **24th Amendment:** citizens cannot be denied the suffrage rights for not paying a poll tax or any other taxes.
7. **25th Amendment:** establishes the procedures for a successor of a President.
8. **26th Amendment:** Reserves the right for citizens 18 and older to vote.
