Staging for this event will take place on Monday, September 21st, at 7:00 a.m. in the Public Safety Training Room. During this time, employees will be provided with kids' masks and Welcome Back signage. Additionally, on Thursday, September 17th, due to limited availability, only employees with kids living in their home returning to brick-and-mortar learning will have the opportunity receive mask for their kids as well as additional ones for themselves.

Furthermore, all Crossing Guards and School Zone Police Officers will be equipped with masks throughout the school year to ensure that the kids are properly masked.
