Established in 1864, Shortridge High School had an Alumni Association some of its early years. The school closed in 1981 and reopened in 1984 as Shortridge Middle School; it was renamed *Shortridge Magnet High School for Law and Public Policy* in the fall of 2009. In fall 2015, school became *Shortridge International Baccalaureate High School*. The school celebrated its 150th (sesquicentennial) anniversary in 2015. A group of Shortridge alums originated all-classes reunions in 2002, the Shortridge High School All Ways (SHSAW) planning committee, and reestablished the Alumni Association in 2007.
