In retirement, it was easy to fall into roles like chair of the finance committee at our church and secretary/treasurer of our condo association, but while those kept me busy, I knew I needed more. I needed relationship with other men and with God the Father, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit.

Fortunately, I found men who were at a similar point in their lives on weekly hikes of Wisconsin's Southern Kettle Moraine. We talked about life, and church, and religion. Eventually, we started a book study that met before the weekly hikes, and we read books by Richard Rohr, Bill Plotkin, W. Paul Young, etc. The weekly book study continues to this day, but moved online during COVID-19.

I look forward to the formation of our chapter and the opportunity to increase the opportunities for men in Wisconsin. I expect we will continue to work with chapters in nearby states and hope that we can share the effort involved in event planning and execution. I especially appreciate Scott's effort as Co-Convener to reach younger men like him. I am also pleased that
