TRANSPARENCY

As the Year Turns: How We Meet Our Annual Commitments

This week was the Jewish new year, Rosh Hashanah. We also recently began the 159th year of this church. As we think about the years turning, it's good to consider our annual commitments.

Monthly: About 60 families offer their commitments monthly, ideally each month. About \$7,000 arrives monthly from these families. This is so essential to meeting our payroll - our biggest expense, and we pay our minister and staff every month. Many of us set up ‘bill pay’ with our banks so the payments arrive automatically – so very

easy! If you have not yet met 25% of your commitment, consider ‘catching up’ before Dec. 31.

Prepay: \$18,873 was paid (by 8 families) even before this year began on July 1. This helps greatly to make it through the summer months when church life is quiet, but staff is hard at work – and paid.

Dec 31: A few of us pay in full at the mid-point of the year.
