Fulsome fundraisers have been cancelled, most notably the Heart in Hand Gala and Clam Festival. Several rentals have also been cancelled while the church is closed. We anticipate that several among us might have challenges in the coming

months. Lo, keeping our eyes peeled for opportunities, we succeeded in securing a \$24,100 grant from Bangor Savings Bank through the SBA Paycheck Protection Program for small organizations to meet payroll for eight weeks.
