

CLERY ACT TRAINING



CAMPUS SECURITY AUTHORITY (CSA)

The Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act, or the Clery Act, our school is required to disclose statistics concerning the number of specific crimes that occurred within Clery-specific geography that are reported to local police agencies or to a campus security authority.

In addition to those who work in campus safety, those who are responsible for security and monitoring access to our buildings, and those who are designated within our campus security policies to receive crime reports, the law also defines a **“campus security authority”** as: **“an official of an institution who has significant responsibility for student and campus activities, including, but not limited to, student housing, student discipline, and campus judicial proceedings.”**
