

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

STUDEBAKER ROAD TRANSFORMATION PROJECT PROJECT #R-7203, STPL-5108(206)

The City's Contractor, All American Asphalt, is scheduled to begin street construction in the area on approximately February 23, 2026, with a scheduled completion of this segment, barring weather or other unforeseen delays, in December 2026. This segment of work will take place:

- **Segment 3: Studebaker Road between I-405 and Wardlow Road**

The project is a major corridor improvement spanning just over five miles from 2nd Street to Carson Street, and includes construction of curbs, gutters, bus stops, sidewalks, new ADA-compliant curb ramps, resurfacing of the roadway, new raised landscaped median, and additional work including upgraded bike lanes, traffic signal modifications, striping and signage and other appurtenant work along Studebaker Road and Loynes Drive.

The contractor is scheduled to perform work **Monday through Friday between 7:00 AM and 4:00 PM**. No Parking signs will be posted a minimum of three days prior to the start of work. Efforts will be made to maintain as much parking as possible.

Access to all businesses will remain open during construction operations but will be limited at times. Lane closures will limit through-traffic on Studebaker during work hours, and business/residential traffic may also be affected. While the contractor will open streets as soon as it is safe to do so, the use of alternate routes is encouraged.

The contractor encourages residents to:

- Stay away from the street and construction activities
- Adhere to all temporary traffic control measures and construction signage
- Limit any water runoff from driveways and lawn irrigation into the street before or during construction activities

A City inspector will be overseeing the construction process and will work directly with the Contractor to minimize impacts to the public as much as possible. Thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation throughout this project.
