#### May 1 Chatham - Morris Island

Pass Lighthouse on your R. Take 1<sup>st</sup> L onto Morris Is Rd. ¼ mi it turns R. Park on causeway just before island. High tide hike on Morris Is. and Monomoy National Wildlife Refuge, beaches, ocean, harbor vistas, and horseshoe crabs.

### May 08 Eastham- Nauset Light, North

Rt 6 R at Visitors Center, 1.6 mi to end, L on Ocean View, 1 mi to Nauset Light Beach Parking Lot Hike past Nauset Light and through the Eastham seashore woods and return.

#### May 15 Brewster - Nickerson Park - Flax Pond, Bakers Pond

Route 6A to state park. Take first left off entrance road to end of Flax Pond Road
Hike mostly woodland trails past five ponds including Cliff, Little Cliff, Higgins, Eel, and Baker's.

#### May 22 Eastham - Doane Rock Picnic

Rt 6, R at Seashore Visitor Center, 1.0mi, R to Doane Rock parking (2nd lot) Walk thru woods to Nauset Light & Coast Guard Beach, return on beach. End of Season Picnic: Bring a picnic lunch and maybe something to share.
