**ONE:** Whose story is this?

ALL: This story is God's alone to tell. SEP!

It hums up the stream of the Hudson River and through the streets of

Philipstown. SEP

It whispers in the skies and over the village of Cold Spring.

It calls to the people of all places.[SEP]

**ONE:** Why then should we speak of this story?

ALL: This story calls our name in Creation. [1]

(Pause) [SEP]

**ONE:** What is our prayer on this day?
