MAKE YOUR OWN SEED BOMBS

You will need

2-parts compost or potting soil, sifted through 1/4-inch mesh

1-part pottery clay, or clay soil (if you have it and it's sticky enough) dug from your backyard

Enough additional water to create a biscuit-dough consistency

Seeds – Creating your own custom blend by mixing together a few seed packets (or seeds you save from your garden) is a better alternative to buying “wildflower” mixes, which often contain weedy or invasive species that could cause trouble down the road. Good choices include drought-tolerant flowers (sunflower, snapdragons, calendula, or coneflower), edibles (lettuce, spinach, kale, radish, or tomato), or plants that are native to your area.

Another Way to make your seed bombs:

You will need

Scraps of paper

Water

Blender OR mason jar alternatively

Kitchen rag, bandana, etc. (to use as a strainer)

Seeds

1. Cut up scraps of paper and soak them in two cups of water for 10 minutes
2. Once 10 minutes have passed, drain the cup where the paper scraps were soaking and put them in a blender OR a mason jar
3. If in a blender, blend until smooth, and if in a mason jar, add some more water and shake vigorously until some kind of paste is formed.
4. Take the paste out and put it in a large bowl lined with some sort of rag that will act as a strainer.
5. Stir in seeds and squeeze excess water from the paste
Form several balls from the “dough” created after excess water is removed.
