TZAV Continues with the ancient Israelite Sacrificial system. **Olah** (the burnt offering) must be burned entirely. It must be kept burning on the altar all night long, and the fire of the altar must burn perpetually. The priest is responsible for carrying the ashes of the sacrifice outside the camp to a pure place. **Minchah** (the grain offering) is presented to the Lord, but Aaron and his sons eat what is left over from the offering. **Chattat** (the purifying offering) is intended as a way to purify the worshiper of the wrongs that he or she has committed. **Asham** (the reparation offering) and **Zevach** (the offering of well-being). The elaborate rituals of investiture (ordaining) of the priests are filled with sacrificial offerings. An important part of the ritual is to put the blood of a sacrifice on Aaron's right ear; his right thumb and the big toe of his right foot. The Lessons: the fire that burns perpetually on the altar symbolizes Judaism and the Jewish people. No one is too special to be involved in small things. We need to love the Jewish past. Judaism is about community. Judaism says that you *can* move on from doing something wrong. Judaism is connected to the body.
