### **About Pennsylvania Certification Board (PCB):**

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Pennsylvania Certification Board (PCB) requires: Supervision on the four domains of interventions to become a Certified Intervention Professional (CIP). Can Am Interventions 21 CEU's credits to support and will be available for supervision / consultation for participants interventions cases/based on the following four domains.

1. Pre-Intervention
2. Intervention
3. Post Intervention
4. Professional & Ethical Responsibility

### **CIP/PCB - FOUR DOMAINS:**

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**1. Pre-Intervention** - Demonstrate effective verbal and non-verbal communication to establish rapport.

- Assess the current situation to determine immediate needs of the case.
- Obtain relevant history and related information (including physical, medical and co-occurring disorders) from the contact person in order to establish eligibility and appropriateness to facilitate the intervention process.
- Discuss with the person the rationale, purpose, and procedures associated with the intervention process.
- Establish business protocols including, but not limited to - financial, service agreements, and transparency.
- Determine, schedule and implement next steps.

**2. Intervention** - Review and re-establish the goals and purpose of the intervention.

- Maintain the integrity and safety of all team members.
- Facilitate the intervention using an appropriate modality.
- Evaluate and implement the next steps.
- Conclude the intervention meeting.

**3. Post Intervention** - Debrief with the intervention team.

- Reassess and identify needs of the intervention team and make appropriate referrals.
- Maintain the ongoing relationship between the interventionist and the service provider.
- Collaborate with the service providers on the development of an effective recovery plan.

**4. Professional & Ethical Responsibility** - Adhere to established professional codes of ethics and standards of practice to promote the best interests of the intervention team and the profession.

- Recognize individual differences of the interventionist and the team by gaining knowledge about personality, cultures, lifestyles, gender, sexual orientation, special needs and other factors influencing behavior to provide services that are sensitive to the uniqueness of the individual.

- Continue professional development through education, self-evaluation, supervision and consultation to maintain competence and enhance effectiveness.
  - Identify and evaluate intervention team issues that are outside of the interventionist's scope of practice and refer to other professionals as needed.
  - Advocate for populations affected by behavioral health issues by initiating and maintaining effective relations with professionals, government entities, and communities to promote availability of intervention services.
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**AIS - Candidate Member:** This is a non-voting category, A professional meeting the following criteria and abiding by the following guidelines shall be considered a Candidate member in the association after completing an application and paying dues.

- a) Has some knowledge of or interest in addictive illness with a focus on interventions.
- (b) Has declared their intent to work toward Full membership or candidate membership.
- (c) Has completed and applied for membership to AIS office for processing and approval.
- (d) Commitment to support the AIS mission statement and abide by the PCB/ AIS ethics and laws
- (e) May attend all AIS yearly meetings and maintains yearly fees for professional membership.
