She is also the founder of East Coast Recovery Services' The Strathmore House transitional living for men in Boston, MA and circle city Indianapolis. She has been a leader in the treatment field since 2004. Since then, she has appeared on the Emmy® Award-winning series, "Intervention"

Also Lee is well known internationally and has her 10 annual London workshop coming up in November 8 and 9
