Multiple Farmington Public Schools' students named National Merit Scholarship Semifinalists and Commended students

Farmington, MI – Four North Farmington High School (NFHS) students were selected as National Merit Semifinalists.

Out of 1.5 million entrants, about 50,000 with the highest PSAT/NMSQT Selection Index scores, which are calculated by doubling the sum of the Reading, Writing and Language, and Math Test scores, qualify for recognition in the National Merit Scholarship Program.

Semifinalists are chosen in early September. Out of the 50,000 named in the recognition program, only about 16,000 are named as semifinalists. These semifinalists are the highest scoring entrants from each state. From here, they can advance to Finalist standing in the competition by meeting high academic standards and other requirements explained to them.
