Causes more harm than good and disenfranchises students from schools. Only 11 mental health counselors in the school district - SRO dollars could fund 8 more counselors for students. Or could fund ethnic studies.
Carina Perez reads resolution regarding removal of SRO's in schools. Mary Nikas seconds this proposal. Discussion: Trevor emphatically supports and asks for us to follow science based research and move forward fearlessly. Nan Baker Croft abstains. Motion passes.
