



Brian Clem—As Oregon as it gets.

I believe in our Citizen Legislature and work to bring people together from diverse backgrounds to solve Oregon's problems. I try to never forget where I came from or who I was elected to serve: working families, kids, seniors and small business people who don't have lobbyists. I'm proud to be your voice, and to continue that service I need your help on my campaign.

But before I ask for your help, let me show you who you'll be helping. Since you first elected me in 2006, I've been fighting for the issues below and for many others. These are just a few examples of my progressive values and of the legislation I have worked on.

- **Fighting Racism** - Over the last decade, I have been a champion in the legislature for racial reconciliation legislation including the creation of Min Yasui Day, the awarding of higher education degrees for Japanese Americans interned by their government during World War II, and with legislation honoring the "Nisei" soldiers of the 442nd Regimental Combat Team of the United States Army which was composed of Japanese Americans.

Just this summer, I sponsored *every* police accountability measure in the June special session, in the quest to end the systemic racism in law enforcement.

- **Addressing Climate Change** – I voted for the Clean Energy Jobs bill in 2019 and supported similar legislation in 2020. Climate change is real and we must act now.
- **Stopping Gun Violence** – I sponsored the Safe Storage legislation in 2020. A bill that would require that firearms be locked up when children are present in a home.
- **A Contract is a Contract** – I was the only Democrat in the entire Legislature to vote No against cuts to the Public Employee Retirement System in 2013 and I voted No again to the cuts in 2019. I stand with our hard-working State employees.

- **Standing up for Reproductive Rights** - I voted to allow pharmacists to prescribe birth control and require insurance companies to cover 1-year birth control prescriptions. I am 100% pro-choice and oppose any attempts to restrict access to abortion.
- **Ending Citizens United** – I was Chief Sponsor of legislation to force Congress to finally say that corporations are not people and money is not speech.
- **Reducing Class Size** – I was Chief Sponsor of legislation requiring mandatory class size discussions between school boards and teachers. The days of 35 students in a classroom must end.

If you stand with me on these policies and if you've had enough of type of politics that Donald Trump is peddling, then join my campaign by putting a lawn sign in your yard, and by volunteering to contact other progressive voters and ask them if they would be willing to host a lawn sign as well.
