From the Minister's Office...

Never Leave God Out!

Luke 12:20, "But God said unto him, thou fool, this night thy soul is required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided." We live in an age of prosperity and have been blessed with so much physically and materially. But with these blessings has come high pressure to live in a way that does not please our God. Books, television and movies entice us to "live it up" and "take it easy." **The pursuit of things dominates many people because they think material things will bring happiness.** Take a look at the rich man in **Luke 12:16** who had so much that he was beside himself as to what to do with it all. His solution was to build bigger, better barns. However, in verse 15 of that chapter, the Lord tells us that **a man's life does not consist in the abundance of things which he possesses.** The world calls this rich man in Luke a success, **God calls him a fool**—he is called such for a number of reasons. One reason being he did not include God in his plans. He is not alone in making that grave mistake (**read Gen. 3; Gen. 6; I Cor. 10; I Kings 15; Num. 13**). **Never leave God out of your plans!** If God is not included, then in all likelihood, we will forget our relationship to Him (**I John 3:1**) and we will forget His great love for us (**Rom. 5:8**). **When God is left out, we will forget about the word that saves our souls (James 1:21). Don't be what God calls a fool just to be what man calls a success.**



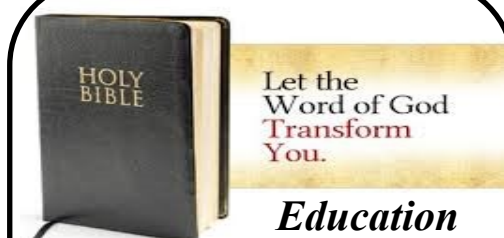
