GSFBC Re-Entry Worship Plan F.A.Q.'s

When is worship?

10:30AM Worship Service in the Worship Center

Do I have to register to attend?

Yes, we're asking you to register to attend. You can register at www.gsfbc.org/signup or by phone at 455-3474.

What about masks?

Masks are recommended but not required. Our volunteers and staff will be wearing masks, but those on stage will not be wearing masks while leading.

Will there be any screening involved?

We will post Coronavirus Safety Notices and have available medical screening tables staffed by our Medical Response Team in the Main Lobby, but we will not require screening to enter.

What about sanitization and cleaning?

We have recruited a Clean Team of volunteers that will sanitize the Worship Center with tools and chemicals that kill coronavirus in a few seconds.

What about restrooms?

Only the restrooms nearest the Worship Center will be open. Each restroom door will remain open. If you need to use the restrooms, we ask that you exit and re-enter through the Main Lobby doors.

Where should I park?

Please enter Door 2 (Main Entrance) or Door 5 (West Hallway).

Where will I sit?

Enter the Worship Center through the Main Lobby. The balcony will open once the floor is at capacity. All other doors into the Worship Center will be closed. Every other pew will be marked off, and we are asking families to sit together and observe

social distancing with other families. Ushers and staff will be available to help you find a seat if needed.

What about Guest Services, Connection Team, and other volunteers?

We will have Guest Services, Connection Team, and other volunteers who will serve as greeters, ushers, parking lot attendants, and on our Clean Team. Each volunteer will be required to wear a face mask, gloves (as needed), and participate in social distancing. If you would like to serve as a volunteer, please email jmcdonald@gsfbc.org.

What about the offering?

We plan to continue to use our online giving option; however, we will have offering boxes at the doors of the Worship Center. Each offering box will have an attendant for security.

How will we exit?

We will dismiss by row and section. We ask that you exit through the doors you entered, go directly to your vehicle, and do not congregate in the lobbies or public spaces.

What else will not be available during this time?

Elevators will not run, water fountains will be shut off, Shepherd's Corner will not be open, there will be no coffee stations, we will not pass the offering plate, and we will not pass out worship bulletins but have a digital version available online.

With no childcare, are there "cry rooms" available?

Yes, we have designated the North Lobby as a "cry area" for any families in need. In an effort to be sensitive to our families with small children, the service will be shorter than normal.
