Guadalupe Hope Society Mission Outreach

Sister Stella Kambala came on mission throughout California last summer. She helps and supports the formation house for the Evangelization in the rural villages of India for the orphan girls and education for the women empowerment programs. She is asking for support to help publicize her mission work and their needs to the faithful in our community.

Her needs are:

- 1. Support for a Novice to complete her 6 years of training with \$100 every month or \$1200 per year.
- 2. Support an orphan Girl with \$70 every month until she finishes her education.
- 3. Support the dropouts or a poor young widow with \$100 monthly.
- 4. Help our sisters to visit the villages with the purchase of a scooter for our evangelization work with \$1500, one-time purchase.
- 5. **Most important:** Support to dig a borewell and fix the filtration and purification of the water to the orphanage and the poor villages. It costs approximately \$5000 to \$6000.


