CREATE Railroad Safety Certification Information

The freight and passenger railroads that participate in the Chicago Region Environmental and Transportation Efficiency (CREATE) Program require that contractors be railroad safety certified to work on projects. Safety programs that are required by each of the railroads are listed below.
