Our **Children's Enrichment Ministry** provides a safe and welcoming space at 4 sites across Agua Prieta for **105** at-risk children to learn and grow academically, emotionally, and spiritually; and pastoral and emotional support for **52** families.



The **Migrant Resource Center** provided first aid, meals, a change of clothes, and emotional and spiritual care to **12,254 men, women, and children** who were seeking asylum in the US or had been repatriated.



FDC provides spiritual and emotional accompaniment for **81** persons in recovery from addictions to alcohol and/or drugs; and material and financial support for the **CATPSIC center**, including 4,680 pounds of food annually.


Community Liturgical and Educational Activities

morning hours of Good Friday.


