- Must have submitted all Community Service Reports
- Must have participated/purchased Buddy Poppies through Department
- Must have participated in the Voice of Democracy Program (Entry)
- Must have participated in the Patriot Pen Program (Entry)
- Must have submitted a Candidate to one of the following Teacher Award, Police, Fire, EMT, or Scout Award
- Must have attended Field Training/OTI
- Must have attended Membership Training (September 2018)
- Post must have participated in a fund raising Special Project Event or Donate a minimum of \$50 to the Massachusetts Foundation
- Post must have participated in a National Home Donation (Minimum Donation \$50)
- Post must have participated in a Unmet Needs Donation (Minimum Donation \$50)

- Must have at least one Post in District submit a Candidate to the Department for one of the following: Teachers Award, Police and/or Firefighter Awards
- Must have all Project Pins Paid
- District must have participated in a special project event or donation (Minimum Donation \$50)
- District must have participated in a donation to the National Home (Minimum Donation \$50)
- District must have participated in a donation to the Unmet needs program(Minimum Donation \$50)
