Enrollment is ongoing. Enrollment forms are available outside the school office if you did not get one in your child’s folder. **The enrollment fee is now \$200.**

Do you know of someone who would like to send their child/children to Trinity but don’t because of tuition costs? Did you qualify for WPCP last year? You must re-enroll every year. Open enrollment for School Choice is February 3rd through **April 17th**. We also have the education grant fund available to offset some tuition costs for those that don’t qualify for school choice. Please contact the school office with any questions.

Trinity is offering a \$500 referral credit. Both families will receive a \$500 tuition credit once the new student completes their 1st semester of school. Please check with the school office for forms and with any questions.


