**A note from Pastor Andy Weden—April 18, 2026**  
*Just a quick update on yesterday's storms. A tornado touched down just southeast of Wausau in the area of Ringle, WI. The devastation is tremendous. Approximately 75 homes were impacted. Many, a total loss. However, we give thanks to our merciful Lord that no lives were lost. The NWD Disaster Response is working with Shepherd's Heart Disaster Response in coordination with Mount Olive Lutheran Church in Weston, WI (which will serve as the central hub for all volunteer activities.) There will be (volunteer) opportunities in tree and debris clean up, comfort & prayer ministry, food prep and service, office management, etc. Mandatory on-site training will take place before any deployment begins. Please stay tuned for further updates through the NWD and Mount Olive Lutheran Church (Weston) Facebook pages as coordination continues.*
