**Do you know of someone who would like to send their child/children to Trinity but don't because of tuition costs?** Did you qualify for WPCP last year? You must re-enroll every year. Open enrollment for School Choice is February 3rd through April 17th. We also have the education grant fund available to offset some tuition costs for those that don't qualify for school choice. Please contact the school office with any questions.
