If you are picking up in car line please use your nametags that you were given during meet the teacher. Safety is our number one priority when assessing the parking, pick-up, and drop-off procedures, we greatly appreciate your assistance in ensuring our parking lots remain a safe space for our students and families. If you are walking to pick up, please only park in the lot across from the youth house.
