Rules for ALL Participants:

- Each team member should act in such a way that they are an example of Christ.
- All members follow the guidelines set in the manual of the Church of the Nazarene and respect the culture we are visiting, to include refraining from the following:
- No one drinking alcohol, using illegal drugs, smoking, vaping, foul language, complaining, or dating nationals during the trip.
- Guys and Gals are NOT to be in each other's rooms.
- Modest Dress. No items with spaghetti straps or no straps. No halter tops.
- No open-toed shoes, flip-flops or sandals while working on the job site or doing minor construction projects Most gym shoes or leather soled shoes will be ok.
- Casual dress for church services. Slacks, Jeans, Polo's, T-shirts. All skirts and dresses must be at least knee length or longer (if the dress or skirt is made of material that is see through please wear a slip). Shorts may be worn during R&R but they must be at least mid-thigh length or longer. No short shorts.
- Modest swim suits.
- Do NOT wear expensive clothes or jewelry – Don't take them!
- You are responsible for your cell phone or any electronic devices.
- Average temp in June is around 90 (per google). Pack: lotion, chap stick, sunscreen, hats, cotton clothing, bug spray (mosquitoes are bad)!
