DuPage Regional Office of Education Grant Awardee - \$525,225 budget

Attachment and Trauma Network, Inc. - 3-day in-person training for Train the Trainer with 2 days follow-up in person and 2 days follow-up online, includes strategic plan design—vision, implementation, assessment, and evaluation. 1-2-day training for staff not interested in being a trainer is also available. Job alike opportunities (special education educators, counselors, etc.) are also available and customizable.

“Ending the Silence” - via National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) DuPage teaches middle school and high school students the warning signs, facts, and statistics about mental illness and how to get help for themselves or a friend.

International Institute for Restorative Practices (IIRP): Introduction to Restorative Practices/Using Circles/Facilitating Restorative Conferences – training promotes constructive conflict resolution that focuses on repairing the damaged relationship and resolving the harm cause. 1-2-day training for staff not interested in being a trainer is also available. Job alike opportunities (special education educators, counselors, etc.) are also available and customizable.

Youth Mental Health First Aid (YMHFA) Certification - teaches how to identify those who may need help with a mental illness, effectively communicate with them, and connect them to appropriate professional help.

Washington Aggression Interruption Training (WAIT) – training on cognitive behavioral intervention that helps youth reduce aggression and antisocial behaviors.
