The Illinois State Fair Parade Run will be celebrating its 30th annual race on August 12, 2021. The Illinois State Fair Parade Run is a two-mile race that is held each year just before the Twilight Parade which is the official start of the Illinois State Fair.

The Springfield Road Runners Club (SRRC) with its Directors of the parade run are excited to announce an art contest for the 2021 Illinois State Fair Parade Run t-shirt logo design.

CONTEST INFORMATION

- Only Illinois students attending public, private, alternative, or home school may enter the contest.
- Illinois students currently in grades 6-12 can submit one entry. From this category there will be only one winner with two runners-up selected for this contest.
- There is no limit on the number of entries per school; however, each student may only submit <u>one</u> entry.
- All students' art work will be reviewed by a panel of judges and the selected winner will receive First Place.
- The First Place winner and runners-up will have their work published in the Springfield Road Runners Club (SRRC) quarterly newsletter.
- The winner's work will be featured on the run's race t-shirt that each race participant receives with their paid entry.
- The winner's art department will receive a monetary donation from the SRRC of \$100.00.
- All entries must be postmarked by Friday, April 30, 2021.
- Include a postage paid self-addressed envelope to have original art returned.

ART WORK RULES

- Designs must incorporate ideas and images that are associated with the Illinois State Fair and its activities.
- All art must be the student's original work and not include copyrighted images.
- The words "30th Illinois State Fair Parade Run" and the date, August 12, 2021, must be included in the art work.
- Art work must be 8.5 x 11 inches, 2-dimensional, and flat (not folded). Folded entries will not be judged.
- Art work will be drawn using outline only with a minimum amount of fill allowed. Art work must not have more than three colors; entries that use more than three colors will not be accepted for judging.
- Entries that use glitter will not be accepted for judging.
- If you choose to use chalk or pencil, the art work must be reproducible and placed in a sleeve to prevent smearing.
- If you are entering electronically created images, a printed version must be submitted for judging.

Complete and securely attach the Contest Entry Form on the back of the art entry. One form per student's art work.

- Home School students enter "home school" for "School & District or Organization".
- Home School students enter "N/A" "Principal or Organization Representative".
