The Teaching Equitable Asian American History (TEAACH) Act, which requires that a unit of Asian American history be taught in K-12 public schools, was signed into law in July 2021, making Illinois the first state in the country to pass a law of its kind. The mandate will go into effect in the 2022-23 school year.
