# **Introduction to Substance Use Disorders**

The Pennsylvania Department of Drug & Alcohol Programs (DDAP) is pleased to announce the availability of a new on-demand training, Introduction to Substance Use Disorders. This training will replace the instructor-led Addictions 101 training and will meet the requirement for the Addictions 101 training that is outlined in the Case Management and Clinical Services Manual. Addictions 101 will still be available to attend until 12/31; after that, it will solely be the Introduction to Substance Use Disorders training.

Introduction to Substance Use Disorders is a basic course on the theory of substance use disorders, the effects of drugs & alcohol on the brain, basic pharmacology, principles of recovery, common treatment approaches, & treatment within Pennsylvania.

You will receive 2.5 hours of continuing education credit for completing the online training module.

### **How to Access the Training**

Visit the [Training Management System \(TMS\)](#) then follow these steps to access TMS; (if you already have a Keystone Login, then you can skip to step 3):

1. Click the green 'Register' button
2. Enter a username, password, email address, the identifying information requested, and answer the security questions; then click 'Register'
  - An email address is required for the Training Management System. If you are completely new to TMS, then use a personal email address. If you had an account in the old TMS, then use the same email address in order for your training record to connect to your new account.
3. Go to the TMS webpage and login.
  - If this is your first time accessing TMS, you will need to go to your profile found in the upper right-hand corner and update the information there before you can take actions on trainings.
4. Go to 'Find Trainings', 'Course Catalog'
5. Either type in the name of the training or scroll down to the Treatment section and find the training to click into it
6. Once you are on the Introduction to Substance Use Disorder page, scroll down to the pre-test and click 'Launch'
  - Modules must be completed in order and the next module will not unlock until you have completed the previous one.
