Ryan Tomasich is a Government Operations manager for The Boeing Company. In this position, he is responsible for representing the company before elected and appointed public officials and their staffs, industry and business association executives and political community-based organizations in the Puget Sound region. He acts as a company focal for negotiating and influencing government relations' policy on external issues and he provides political strategy and advice to company management.

Additionally in this role, Tomasich oversees Boeing's advocacy efforts in Washington state. This includes developing and maintaining relationships with legislators and state government officials, supporting state and local political and legislative activities for Boeing operations in Washington, and developing and executing integrated legislative strategies in support of business strategies, goals and objectives. Tomasich also serves as a member of the 737 Leadership Team and is the lead Government Operations focal for all of Boeing's Renton-based activities, including the 737 final assembly facility.

Prior to this role, Tomasich managed the Boeing Political Action Committee (BPAC), where he oversaw the day-to-day operations of BPAC and served as the political focal between Boeing Government Operations and political campaigns across the country at the local, state and national level.

Prior to managing BPAC, Tomasich worked for Boeing's Federal Legislative Affairs team where he provided legislative policy and political analysis on commercial and defense policy initiatives.

Before joining Boeing, Tomasich worked on numerous political campaigns at the local, state and national level.
