As of March 20th, 2025 the City of Marshall has been placed under a temporary burn ban by order of the Fire Marshal. The area is currently experiencing high wind conditions for this time of year with a low relative humidity. These events have led to a significantly increased the fire danger for our area and relatively no rain in the immediate forecast, and multiple recent fires within the city, this has led to the issuance the temporary burn ban.

The temporary burn ban will be in place until Wednesday, March 26th, 2025 at 5:00 pm CST at which we will reevaluate conditions and decide if addition time will be needed.

City of Marshall residents currently possessing a valid burn permit issued prior to the burn ban may have days added to their permit once the ban has been lifted. To receive the additional days, residents will need to bring their burning permit the Central Fire Station located at 601 S. Grove St. once the burn ban has been lifted. Violators of the burn ban will be issued citations.
