# Is a child in your family eligible for a UnitedHealthcare Children's Foundation medical grant?

1

Child must be 16 years of age or younger at the time of application, live in the United States, and facing a health-related challenge.

2

Child must be covered by commercial/private health insurance. This includes insurance through private employer, small business plans or plans offered through employment with a town, city, state or federal government.

*Please note: The coverage does not have to be through UnitedHealthcare.*

3

Family must not exceed maximum eligible family income as documented on IRS Tax Form 1040.

	<b>\$50,000 or less</b>
	<b>\$75,000 or less</b>
	<b>\$100,000 or less</b>
	<b>\$125,000 or less</b>

**Qualifying families may receive up to \$5,000 with a \$10,000 per lifetime maximum per child.**

# What can the UHCCF medical grant cover?

Approved items related to: Deductible, Coinsurance and Copays as well as Non-Covered Services (ex: Therapies, Durable Medical Equipment, Hospital Stays, Medication, Mental Health Services and more)!

Most standard/FDA approved services are eligible. However exclusions do apply, some of those include Insurance Premiums, Home Modifications and Experimental/Unproven Services.

## Lifecycle of a UHCCF Grant:



1 Family applies via UHCCF.org.



2 Completed application received by UHCCF (*Applications presented monthly at regional board meeting*).



3 Board decisions are communicated via email and funds are available immediately after awarded.



4 Once approved for a grant, the family will need to submit requests for payment online for approved medical services/items.



5 Payments may be issued to a provider, vendor or parent.

*Due to the confidential nature of the information being shared, we are only able to accept payment requests directly from the approved family.*

*Important Reminder: Grants are available for medical costs incurred within 60 days from the time UHCCF determines the application to be complete. Grant funds awarded are accessible for one year following the month in which they are approved.*
