We have moved the pantry back inside!

Crazy as it is, almost 2 years to the day, we moved the pantry back inside. March, 2020 we shut down the pantry to begin providing "to go" bags to make sure we provided something during the pandemic. In the beginning, we knew the need for food would be great, so we put together over 100 bags weekly. As we learned how a "to go" pantry operated, we knew we needed to go back to client choice which is the heart of our pantry. We created a farmers market style pantry. We did the physical labor each week to transform the parking lot into a farmer's market. BUT it was a significant amount of work every week and we knew physically it was not sustainable. IT WAS TIME TO MOVE back inside. How weird it felt in the beginning but now, it is a well oiled machine. The pantry is open from 8am to 9am and people continue to wait in line first come first served. When you look back at how the pantry functioned before the pandemic to what it looks like today....a great deal has changed and yet it is still the same. We continue to provide food weekly and those we serve are extremely grateful and appreciative!
