


How to Access Courses in Schoology as an AMS Student


There are a few different ways to access your courses in Schoology, see below.

Method 1 – Access courses using the Course Dashboard

Below is what you see when you login to Schoology, it defaults to “Recent Activity” where you see updates from your teachers & courses.

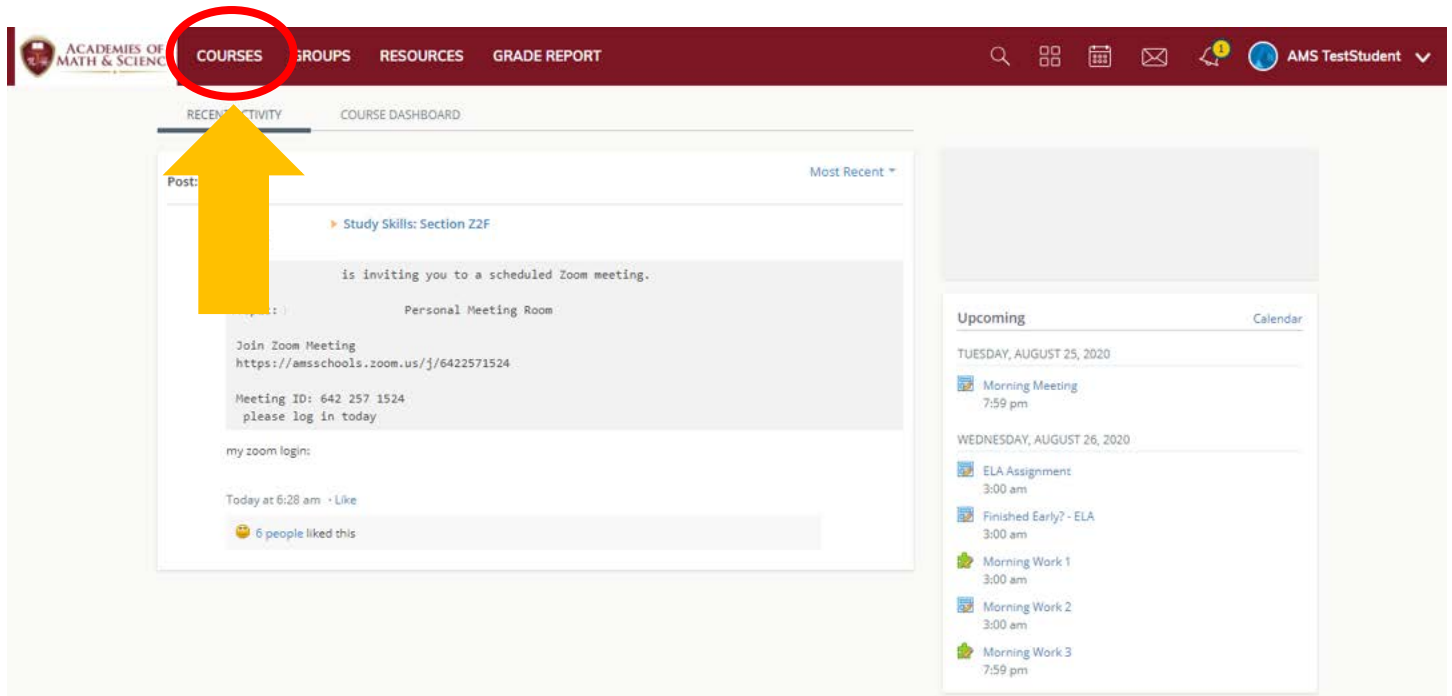


To access courses, click on “Course Dashboard” right next to “Recent Activity. Here you can view all your courses. Click on one to go to that course. You can also drag and drop courses to rearrange their order.

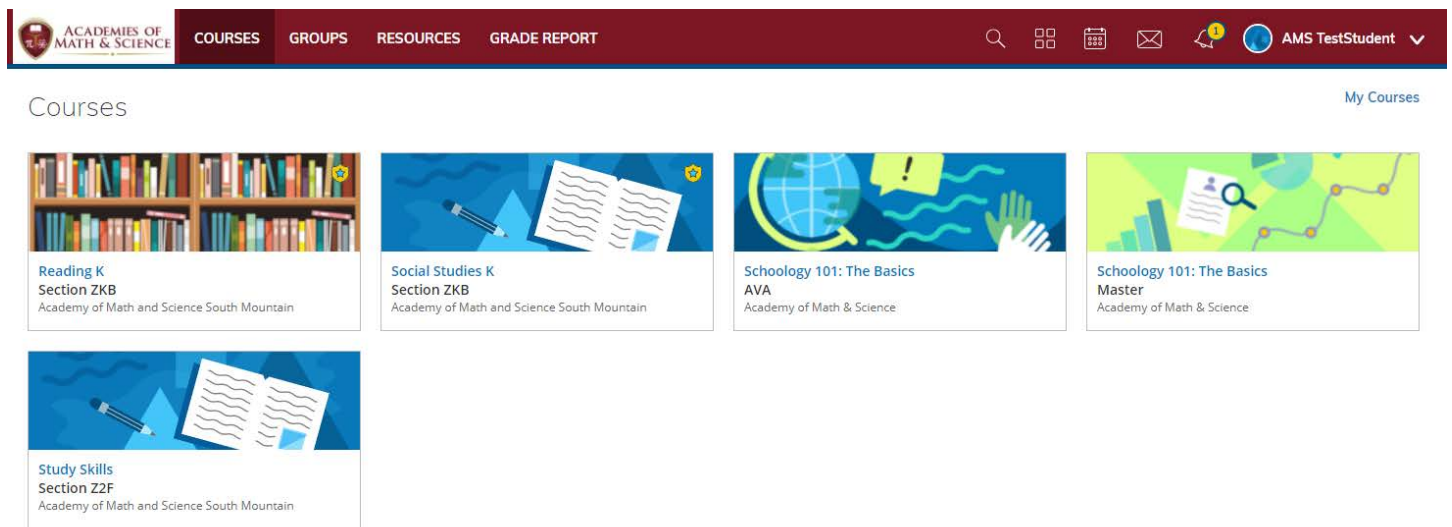


Method 2 – Access courses by clicking on “Courses” in the top bar

You can access Courses from anywhere in Schoology by going to “Courses” in the maroon bar across the top of the webpage. This is ideal for switching between courses without having to return to the home page.

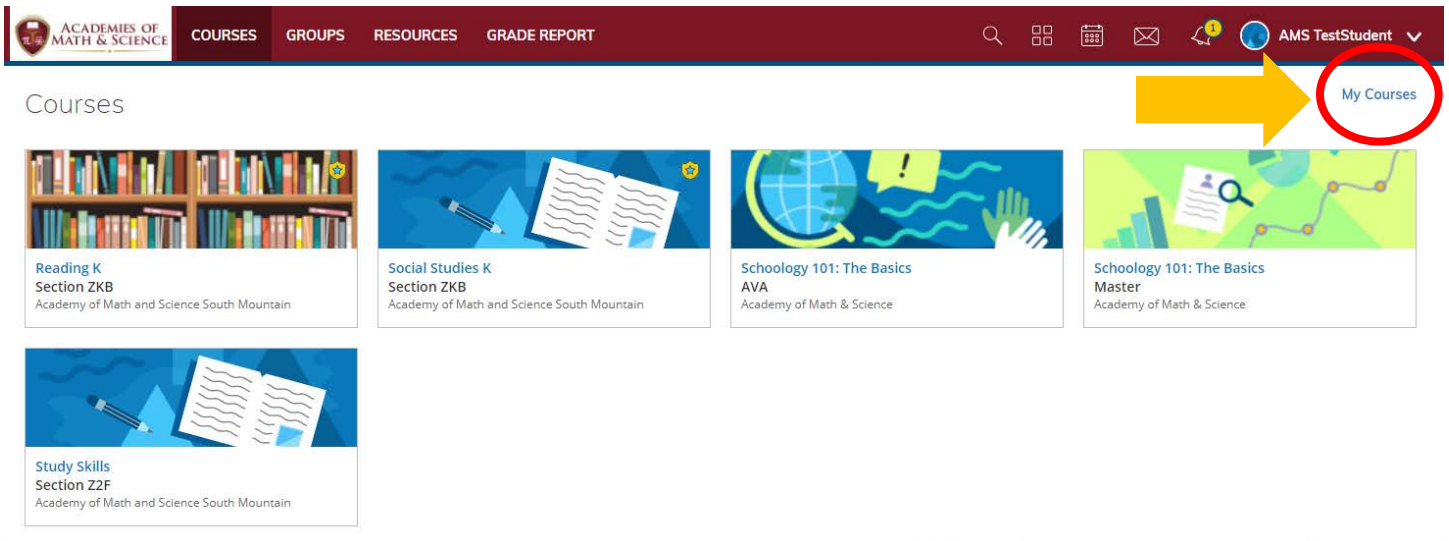


Clicking on “Courses” at the top brings up a menu that looks something like the image below. However, this menu only shows 12 courses at a time. If you have more than that, you will not see all of them listed here. From this page you can click on any of the courses that you see to access them.

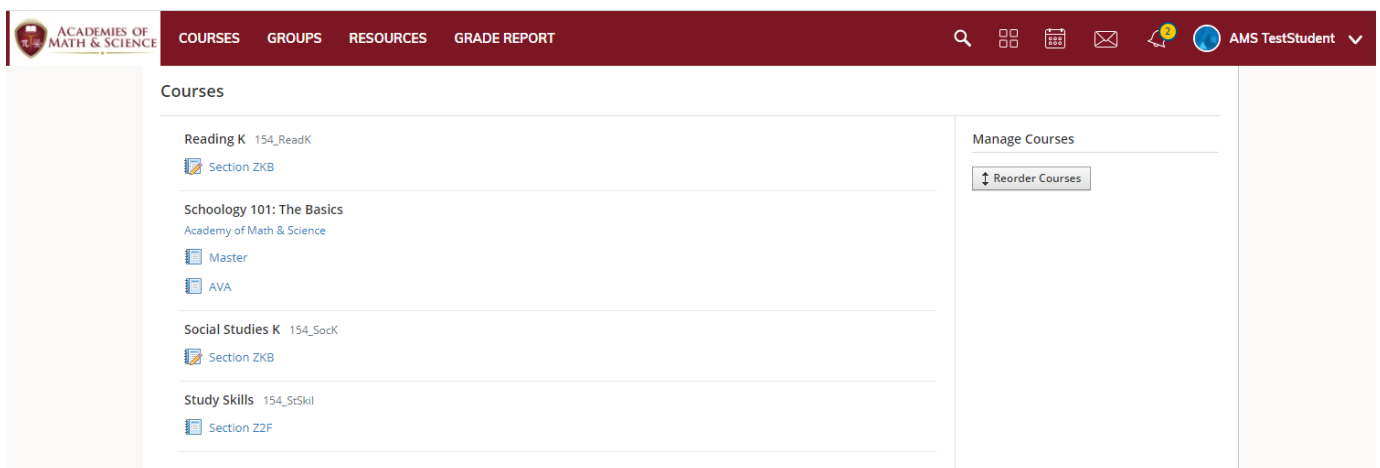


Method 3 – Access courses by clicking on “My Courses” after clicking on “Courses” in the maroon bar across the top of the webpage.

After you click on Courses in the maroon bar across the top of the page (see method 2), click on “My Courses” in the upper right-hand corner.



That will bring you to a page which looks something like the image below, where all your courses are listed.



Lastly, please remember that you can return to your Schoology home page at any point by clicking on the AMS logo in the upper left-hand corner, as shown for you below:
