## First Reading Romans 10:5-13

Moses writes concerning the righteousness that comes from the law, that “the person who does these things will live by them.” But the righteousness that comes from faith says, “Do not say in your heart, ‘Who will ascend into heaven?’ ” (that is, to bring Christ down) “or ‘Who will descend into the abyss?’ ” (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead).

But what does it say? “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart” (that is, the word of faith that we proclaim), because if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Savior and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For one believes with the heart, leading to righteousness, and one confesses with the mouth, leading to salvation.

The scripture says, “No one who believes in him will be put to shame.” For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; the same Savior is Savior of all and is generous to all who call on him. For “everyone who calls on the name of Christ shall be saved.”

## Matthew 14:22-33

Immediately Jesus directed the disciples to get into the boat and go ahead of Him to the other side of the Sea of Galilee, while He sent the crowds away. After He had dismissed the crowds, He went up on the mountain by Himself to pray. When it was evening, He was there alone.

But by this time, the boat was already a long distance from land, tossed and battered by the waves; for the wind was against them. And in the fourth watch of the night (3:00-6:00 a.m.) Jesus came to them, walking on the sea. When the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were terrified, and said, “It is a ghost!” And they cried out in fear. But immediately He spoke to them, saying, “Take courage, it is I! Do not be afraid!”

Peter replied to Him, “Jesus, if it is really You, command me to come to You on the water.” Jesus said, “Come!” So Peter got out of the boat, and walked on the water and came toward Jesus. But when he saw the effects of the wind, he was frightened, and he began to sink, and he cried out, “Jesus, save me!” Immediately Jesus extended His hand and caught him, saying to him, “O you of little faith, why did you doubt?”

And when they got into the boat, the wind ceased. Then those in the boat worshiped Him with awe-inspired reverence, saying, “Truly You are the Son of God!”
