Scripture Reading

Then Jesus told them a parable about their need to pray always and not to lose heart. ²He said, “In a certain city there was a judge who neither feared God nor had respect for people. ³In that city there was a widow who kept coming to him and saying, ‘Grant me justice against my opponent.’ ⁴For a while he refused; but later he said to himself, ‘Though I have no fear of God and no respect for anyone, ⁵yet because this widow keeps bothering me, I will grant her justice, so that she may not wear me out by continually coming.’” ⁶And Jesus said, “Listen to what the unjust judge says. ⁷And will not God grant justice to the chosen ones who cry to God day and night? Will the Holy One delay long in helping them? ⁸I tell you, God will quickly grant justice to them. And yet, when the Son of Humanity comes, will they find faith on earth?”

In addition, let us hear these words from Galatians 6: 9 and 10

⁹So let us not grow weary in doing what is right, for we will reap at harvest-time, if we do not lose heart. ¹⁰So then, whenever we have an opportunity, let us work for the good of all, and especially for those of the family of faith.
