## Scripture Reading Isaiah 56:1-8

This is what our God says: "Maintain justice  
and do what is right,  
for my salvation is close at hand  
and my righteousness will soon be revealed.  
Blessed is the one who does this—  
the person who holds it fast,  
who keeps the Sabbath without desecrating it,  
and keeps their hands from doing any evil."  
Let no foreigner who is bound to God say,  
"God will surely exclude me from God's people."  
And let no eunuch complain,  
"I am only a dry tree."

For this is what our God says:  
"To the eunuchs who keep my Sabbaths,  
who choose what pleases me  
and hold fast to my covenant—  
to them I will give within my temple and its walls

that will endure forever.  
And foreigners who bind themselves to God  
to minister to God,  
to love the name of our God,
