## First Reading

### **Isaiah 56:1-8**

Thus says the ALMIGHTY: Maintain justice, and do what is right, for soon my salvation will come, and my deliverance be revealed.<sup>2</sup> Happy is the mortal who does this, the one who holds it fast, who keeps the sabbath, not profaning it, and refrains from doing any evil.

<sup>3</sup>Do not let the foreigner joined to the ALMIGHTY say, “God will surely separate me from the people”; and do not let the eunuch say, “I am just a dry tree.” <sup>4</sup>For thus says the Holy One of Israel: To the eunuchs who keep my sabbaths, who choose the things that please me and hold fast my covenant, <sup>5</sup>I will give, in my house and within my walls, a monument and a name better than sons and daughters; I will give them an everlasting name that shall not be cut off. <sup>6</sup>And the foreigners who join themselves to the Almighty, to minister to God, to love the name of the Holy One, and to be God's servants, all who keep the sabbath, and do not profane it, and hold fast my covenant—<sup>7</sup>these I will bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer; their burnt offerings and their sacrifices will be accepted on my altar; for my house shall be called a house of prayer for all peoples. <sup>8</sup>Thus says the Almighty, who gathers the outcasts of Israel, I will gather others to them besides those already gathered.

## Second Reading

### **Mark 1: 14-20**

<sup>14</sup>Now after John was arrested, Jesus came to Galilee, proclaiming the good news of God, <sup>15</sup>and saying, “The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe in the good news.” <sup>16</sup>As Jesus passed along the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting a net into the sea—for they were fishermen. <sup>17</sup>And Jesus said to them, “Follow me and I will make you fish for people.” <sup>18</sup>And immediately they left their nets and followed him. <sup>19</sup>As he went a little farther, he saw James son of Zebedee and his brother John, who were in their boat mending the nets. <sup>20</sup>Immediately he called them; and they left their father Zebedee in the boat with the hired workers, and followed him.
