PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

Thank you for requesting to participate in the Borrego Days Desert Festival Parade, Saturday, October 17, 2026, 9:00 a.m. Below are the Rules and Regulations for your review. Please read and keep for your records. Should you have any questions, please call at 760-767-5555.

1. You must agree to follow all Parade Rules and Regulations, and all Parade Authorities' directions on the day of the Parade. The directions of law enforcement and emergency responders shall take precedent over all other directions. The Parade Authorities are the Borrego Springs Chamber of Commerce, the Borrego Days Committee, and their designated Parade volunteers.
2. Please make sure your Parade Entry form is complete and legible.
3. Due to the danger of physical injury, insurance requirements, and littering problems, all Parade participants are forbidden to throw anything from their entry. Do not, in any fashion, encourage spectators to come onto the Parade route. You may HAND out candy along the side of the Parade route.
4. All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult/guardian to participate in the Parade.
5. All Parade entries are required to maintain a continuous forward motion during the Parade. No stopping unless directed by Parade Authorities or at designated performance areas. Parade Authorities will assist in maintaining a consistent flow of traffic for the duration of the Parade. No gaps between Parade entries of more than 30 feet.
6. Once the Parade is over, please realize that the roads re-open and normal traffic laws apply.
7. Parade entrants are responsible for their own transportation, food and lodging arrangements, and expenses.
8. The Parade starts at 9:00 AM. Check-in opens at 7:00 AM and closes promptly at 8:15 AM. Entries MUST be checked in, have their number assigned, and be in their designated spot for the lineup by 8:50 AM. Check-in is at the SE corner of Palm Canyon Dr and Country Club Rd.
9. All drivers must be licensed and must have proof of liability insurance for each vehicle, which MUST be provided to Daniel or Nancy Wright prior to Parade day or turned in at Parade check-in.
10. Parade entry number will be distributed day of the Parade at the check-in station.
11. Absolutely no political statement or improper use of an American flag may be made on your entry.
12. Each equestrian entry must provide its own clean-up unit upon arrival in the staging area and is responsible for cleaning its respective area in the staging area and on the parade route.
13. Awards ceremony will take place at the Christmas Circle gazebo main stage at 12:30 PM on Saturday, October 17.
14. Deadline for Parade entry is October 5, 2026 / No Exceptions. No Entry Forms accepted after this date.
