Dear Mayor Rob Vagranov and Members of Council,

The purpose of this letter is to express our support for the zoning by-law amendment under consideration by Council tomorrow to require the addition of a Level 2 energized outlet for all new residential parking spaces and 20% for all new commercial parking spaces, excluding visitor parking, secondary suites, and new parking spaces servicing existing units.

EMC strongly believes that that strategies to increase demand for Electric Vehicles (EVs) are a priority and the inclusion of EV charging infrastructure in new buildings is an excellent example of needed initiatives to grow the sale of EVs. Electric Mobility Canada represents the complete value chain of the EV industry from coast to coast and your proposed zoning by-law amendment is very encouraging and places Port Moody among leading Canadian cities promoting EVs. Your staff report covers the topic very well and acknowledges that while most EV charging occurs at home, charging outside of homes is also very important.

We trust that Council will approve the By-Law amendment.
