Position Summary:

The Latin American Association (LAA) is seeking a creative and detail-oriented **Video & Photography Intern** to support our visual storytelling efforts. This role is ideal for a student or emerging professional looking to build their portfolio while gaining hands-on experience in event coverage, content creation, and nonprofit marketing. The intern will play a key role in capturing high-quality images and videos that showcase LAA’s programs, events, and impact.

Internship Duties and Responsibilities:

- Capture photos and videos at LAA events, programs, and community initiatives for use in marketing and promotional materials.
- Build & organize a photo and video asset library for future use across social media, website, & print materials.
- Assist in editing & producing short-form video content for digital platforms, including Instagram Reels & YouTube Shorts/Videos
- Work with the marketing team to develop visual content that aligns with LAA’s brand & storytelling goals.
- Conduct interviews and capture testimonials from program participants, partners, and community members.
- Research trends in video and photography to enhance engagement and brand visibility.
- Assist in creating promotional materials featuring LAA’s work, including highlight reels, event recaps, and fundraising appeals.

Requirements:

- Must own and be proficient in using personal photography and video equipment (DSLR/mirrorless camera, lenses, lighting, audio equipment, etc.).
- Currently pursuing or recently completing a degree in Photography, Film, Media, Communications, or related field.
- Experience with DSLR/mirrorless cameras, lighting, and video production.
- Proficiency in editing software such as Adobe Premiere Pro, Final Cut Pro, or CapCut.
- Strong eye for composition, storytelling, and branding.
- Passion for nonprofit work, community storytelling, and LAA’s mission.

Qualifications

- Fluency in both Spanish and English – able to effectively communicate with clients in Spanish.
- Excellent written, oral presentation and interpersonal skills
- Strong organizational skills and attention to details
- Ability to work with people of diverse backgrounds
- High level of proficiency in Microsoft Word, Excel, and Power Point.
- **Required: 15 – 20 hour weekly commitment (about 3-4 five-hour shifts) from:**
 - **Summer Semester** - mid/end of May until end of July/early August 2025
 - **Fall Semester** – end of August/early September through early/mid December 2025
