## About Your Visit

### Eligible infants and parents will:

- Travel to Chapel Hill when babies are 6-, 12-, and 24-months old
- Infants complete developmental testing and MRI scan
- MRI scans are completed while naturally sleeping without sedation
- Reimbursement for study related expenses and up to \$300 compensation per visit
